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**ORDER:-**

The Registrar (Judicial-I), FAC Registrar (Recruitment), High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad in his letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above has stated that, as per the existing Telangana State Judicial (Service and Cadre) Rules, 2023, one percent reservation is provided for Physically Challenged [Orthopedically Handicapped (lower portion of the body)] persons in the appointments to be made by direct recruitment in the categories of District Judges and Civil Judges (Junior Division), that one Sri Anil Kumar Kompally, PP, CBI, ACB, Hyderabad, has submitted a representation on 19.03.2022, requesting to provide one (01) percent reservation in favour of the visually challenged persons in the direct recruitment notification as per the verdict, dated 11.02.2021 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.273 of 2021 (Vikash Kumar Vs. Union Public Service Commission and others).

2. The Registrar (Judicial-I), FAC Registrar (Recruitment), High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad has further stated that, the High Court has considered the representation of said individual and decided to provide 4% reservation to persons differently-abled (including visually challenged candidates) in the Telangana State Judicial Service and requested to issue orders amending the Rule 33 of Telangana State Judicial (Service and Cadre) Rules, 2023 issued in the GO 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, for providing 4% reservation to persons differently-abled, in terms of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, in a Unit of hundred vacancies as per the order of rotation specified in the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

3. Government, after careful consideration of the proposal of the High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad received vide letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, approves the same and decided to issue the following amendment to the Telangana State Judicial (Service and Cadre) Rules, 2023, issued in the G.O.3<sup>rd</sup> read above.

4. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the next Telangana Gazette.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 223, 234, 235, 237 read with the proviso to Article 309 and proviso to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India and all other powers hereunto enabling and in consultation with the High Court for the State of Telangana, the Governor of Telangana, hereby makes the following amendments to the Telangana State Judicial (Service and Cadre) Rules, 2023 issued in G.O.Ms.No.36, General Administration (J&RA) Department, dated 10.06.2023 as subsequently amended from time to time:-

**AMENDMENT**

In the said rules, for rule 33, for the words "one percent for physically challenged [Orthopedically Handicapped (lower portion of the body)] persons", the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"four percent (4%) reservation to the persons differently abled as detailed below in terms of the Right of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act No.49 of 2016), in a unit of 100 vacancies as per the order of rotation specified in the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996".
